in-home supportive services (ihss) program live-in family ... - the ihss program has created a family-member exemption to the workweek maximum of 66 hours for ihss providers to allow them to work up to a maximum of 90 hours per workweek and up to a maximum of 360 hours a month. in order to be eligible for this exemption, you must meet the three (3) following conditions on or before january 31, 2016:
